1. Introduction

Hutchinson County of Texas is seeking bids from qualified contractors for the installation of a generator at the Hutchinson County Annex building located in Borger, Texas. The purpose of this IFB is to identify and select a contractor or contractors who can provide efficient, cost-effective, and environmentally responsible services.

This procurement and any resulting contract are funded in whole or in part with financial assistance provided through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) and administered by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM). Accordingly, the procurement and the resulting contract shall be subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, executive orders, and grant requirements, including, without limitation, the procurement standards at 2 CFR Part 200 and the contract provisions required by Appendix II to 2 CFR Part 200, as applicable to the awarded contract. The successful bidder must agree to comply with all such requirements and to execute all certifications, disclosures, and other forms required as a condition of award.

2. Scope of Work

The selected contractor will be responsible for the following tasks:

- Provide labor, machinery, and materials to install a 20' x 20' concrete pad, RS150 Quiet Connect Cummins generator or equal product, 600A automatic transfer switch, and security fence.
- Provide labor, machinery, and materials to remove old concrete, bore 240 ft south, and install a natural gas line.
- Provide labor, machinery, and materials to consolidate two electric service feeds into a single electric service feed.

3. Bid Requirements

Bids should include the following information:

- **Company Information:** Name, address, and contact details of the company.
- **Experience:** Description of the company's experience with similar projects.
- **Methodology:** Detailed plan for concrete pad, generator, and transfer switch installation, including equipment to be used and timeline.
- **Cost:** Detailed cost breakdown, including, but not limited to, the following and any additional fees:
 - RS150 Quiet Connect Cummins Generator or Equal Product
 - Generator Freight
 - 600A Automatic Transfer Switch
 - Transfer Switch Installation Labor
 - Existing Concrete Demolition
 - Concrete Pad Material
 - Concrete Pad Installation Labor
 - Conduit Material
 - Conduit Installation Labor
 - Security Fence Material
 - Security Fence Installation Labor
 - Gas Line Boring
 - Service Feed Consolidation Labor
- **Compliance:** Proof of compliance with all relevant regulations and certifications. (If applicable.)
- **References:** Contact information for at least three references from similar projects.
- **Bond/License:** A 5% bid bond, 100% payment bond, and 100% performance bond.
- **Affidavit:** Must sign all Affidavit(s) provided by Hutchinson County in this packet.

4. Bid Opening and Award

All bids received by the stated deadline will be publicly opened and read aloud at the October 13, 2026 Commissioners Meeting. Hutchinson County will review bids to determine whether each bid is responsive to the requirements of this solicitation and whether the bidder is responsible, including having the ability, resources, experience, and eligibility to perform the contract. Subject to applicable federal, state, and local requirements, including 2 CFR Part 200, Hutchinson County intends to award a firm-fixed-price contract to the lowest responsive bid submitted by a responsible bidder.

5. Submission Instructions

Sealed Bids must be received on or before September 30, 2026 no later than 3 PM. All submissions can be made by

CONFLICT OF INTEREST QUESTIONNAIRE
For vendor doing business with local governmental entity

A complete copy of Chapter 176 of the Local Government Code may be found at <http://www.statutes.legis.state.tx.us/Docs/LG/htm/LG.176.htm>. For easy reference, below are some of the sections cited on this form.

Local Government Code § 176.001(1-a): "Business relationship" means a connection between two or more parties based on commercial activity of one of the parties. The term does not include a connection based on:

- (A) a transaction that is subject to rate or fee regulation by a federal, state, or local governmental entity or an agency of a federal, state, or local governmental entity;
- (B) a transaction conducted at a price and subject to terms available to the public; or
- (C) a purchase or lease of goods or services from a person that is chartered by a state or federal agency and that is subject to regular examination by, and reporting to, that agency.

Local Government Code § 176.003(a)(2)(A) and (B):

(a) A local government officer shall file a conflicts disclosure statement with respect to a vendor if:

(2) the vendor:

(A) has an employment or other business relationship with the local government officer or a family member of the officer that results in the officer or family member receiving taxable income, other than investment income, that exceeds \$2,500 during the 12-month period preceding the date that the officer becomes aware that

(i) a contract between the local governmental entity and vendor has been executed;

or

(ii) the local governmental entity is considering entering into a contract with the vendor;

(B) has given to the local government officer or a family member of the officer one or more gifts that have an aggregate value of more than \$100 in the 12-month period preceding the date the officer becomes aware that:

- (i) a contract between the local governmental entity and vendor has been executed; or
- (ii) the local governmental entity is considering entering into a contract with the vendor.

(1) the date that the vendor:

(A) begins discussions or negotiations to enter into a contract with the local governmental entity; or

(B) submits to the local governmental entity an application, response to a request for proposals or bids, correspondence, or another writing related to a potential contract with the local governmental entity; or

(2) the date the vendor becomes aware:

(A) of an employment or other business relationship with a local government officer, or a family member of the officer, described by Subsection (a);

(B) that the vendor has given one or more gifts described by Subsection (a); or

(C) of a family relationship with a local government officer.
