**BUDGET COVER PAGE**

This budget will raise less revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$-401,309, which is a -2.95 percent decrease from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$53,521.00.


