

APPLICATION FOR BALLOT BY MAIL

September 9, 2021

In Texas, in order to vote by mail, a voter must have a qualifying reason. A voter may vote early by mail if they:

- **Are 65 years of age or older; or**
- **Have a Disability (as defined in Texas Election Code 82.002(a) By checking this box, “I affirm that I have a sickness or physical condition that prevents me from appearing at the polling place on election day without a likelihood of needing personal assistance or of injuring my health.”; or**
- **Are expected to give birth within three weeks before or after Election Day; or**
- **Are expected to be absent from the County (You may apply for a ballot for one election and its resulting runoff, if your dates of absence from the county include both election); or**
- **Are confined in Jail of Involuntary Civil Commitment (You may only apply for a ballot for one election and any resulting runoff)**
