- Bailiff serves at the will of the judge of the 316th District Court

Duties:

- Selection, implementation and the proper maintenance of all courtroom security systems necessary for the security of the Court, the litigants and the public. Procurement and maintenance of all necessary security equipment essential to the promotion of a safe and secure courtroom environment.
- Selection, establishment and implementation of all security procedures necessary for courtroom security. The Bailiff shall continually monitor all courtroom situations and shall take all necessary actions, including the use of deadly force, when, if and in the event such is required in order to protect the lives of all present. In this regard, the Bailiff shall use his training and expertise to properly secure the courtroom environment.
- Determination, preparation and submission to the Court of all necessary and proper budgetary items relating to the duties of the Bailiff of the 316th District Court.
- The Bailiff shall serve as part of the security force for the district and county courts in the county and for the courthouse and shall perform other duties as required by the judge of the 316th District Court.
- In the absence of the 316th District Court Administrator, the Bailiff shall answer all inquiries and shall make settings for the Court as he determines.
