

DRESS CODE FOR JUSTICE OF THE PEACE-PRECINCT #2 COURT HUTCHINSON COUNTY, TEXAS

THE FOLLOWING CHANGES ARE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY!

The attached dress code identifies articles of clothing that are inappropriate for courtroom appearances. This list is not all inclusive and the Court reserves the right to deny entrance into the courtroom if the person's dress is deemed inappropriate. These rules pertain to all defendants, witnesses, family members, and courtroom participants. Each person is responsible to observe when appearing in court. A copy of this policy will be posted outside the Justice of the Peace Precinct #2 Courtroom.

It should also be noted that while this dress code applies to all court participants, attorneys and court room personnel are held to a stricter standard.

- NO HATS OR CAPS
- NO FLIP FLOPS
- NO HALTER TOPS
- NO MIDRIFF TOPS
- NO TANK TOPS
- NO OPEN-BACK TOPS
- LEGGINGS ONLY WITH APPROPRIATE DRESS/SKIRT
- NO CLOTHING WITH OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE OR SYMBOLS
- NO WARM-UPS, SPANDEX, EXERCISE CLOTHING OR SLEEP CLOTHING
- NO SUNGLASSES WITHOUT DOCTOR VERIFIED STATEMENT
- NO PIERCINGS OTHER THAN EARS
- NO SHORTS
- NO RIPPED/TORN/DISTRESSED JEANS
